## ROLL CALL AND INSPECTION WILL IMMEDIATELY FOLLOW THE CLOSE OF ENTRIES

All hounds to be inspected for entry in the AKC JC or QC Test(s) and/or Trials must be presented WITHOUT TAPE, BANDAGES or WRAPPING on the toes, feet, or legs. Committee members may request that cold-weather coverings such as blankets, coats and pajamas be removed from hounds under inspection.

## DIRECTIONS

**From the north or south on Interstate5 :** Take the Auburn Exit (Exit 18). Go to Auburn and take the Enumclaw Exit to Highway 164. Follow the signs to Enumclaw (Highway 410). Just before Enumclaw, turn right on 244<sup>th</sup> go to 56<sup>th</sup> and turn left which becomes Warner. Stay on Warner until the fairgrounds.

**Going South on 405 or coming from the Renton area:** Go east on Maple Valley Highway (Highway 169). Go through Black Diamond and continue on until 416 th SE. Turn left then follow signs until the fairgrounds.



**Qualified Courser Certificate**

**Instructions:** *This form is to be used when a hound successfully completes the Qualified Courser Test at an AKC® Lure Coursing event. A hound must have received this certification within one year of the closing date of the trial being entered to be eligible to compete in an AKC Lure Coursing Trial in the Open or Open Veteran stake. This form must be properly completed and submitted along with this hound's first entry in an AKC Lure Coursing Trial in either stake.*

*\* Hounds who have earned a Field Championship from either the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) are exempt from this requirement. A copy of the applicable FC certificate must accompany the first entry of these hounds.*

**TESTS & STAKES OFFERED**

**JUNIOR COURSER TEST**

Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge assigned to one test and a second certification from a different judge assigned to another test, stating that the hound completed a 600-yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. It is strongly recommended that hounds that pass their JC test should be practiced with other hounds before being entered in the Open Stake to ensure absence of aggression on the field.

**QUALIFIED COURSER TEST**

A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed—or another breed with a similar running style—(Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

## ELIGIBLE HOUNDS

Only purebred Cirnechi dell'Etna that are one year of age or older, that have been registered with the AKC, or part of an AKC – registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the USA and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry are eligible to participate.

## STAKES OFFERED

**OPEN:** Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title of record are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

**SPECIAL:** Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

**VETERAN:** Is offered at the option of the host club. It is open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

**SINGLES:** Open to all Cirnechi dell'Etna. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds entered in the Singles Stake shall not be allowed to enter the regular stakes (Open, Special or Veteran) at the same event. Each hound shall run the course alone. The order of running shall be determined by random draw. Judges shall score a dog's performance the same as a regular stake. Placements shall be awarded based on the combined preliminary and final course scores. The winner of the stake shall not be eligible to compete in Best of Breed. Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

## REFUNDS & SUBSTITUTIONS

Pre-entry fees submitted and accepted with pre-entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for early-entries. Requests may be made by time-stamped email to the FTS or by direct contact (phone or in person) with the FTS. No refunds for pre-entry fees will be returned after the closing of early-entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season

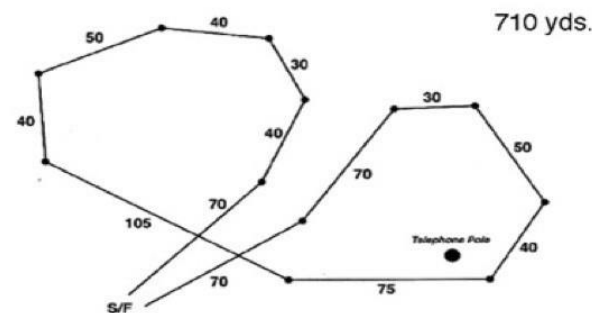

## NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.

Each hound requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.

Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be refused entry and, if presented at inspection, will be refunded entry fees. Each entry will be examined and wicketed at inspection.

Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds may not be entered.

Spayed or neutered hounds may be entered.

The lure will consist of plastic contrasting in color with the immediate field environment.

Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled. No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC/CdECA/any hound(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.

The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators.

All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the club. All persons and animals attending these shows grant the club the right to use their likeness and voice in any matter without further consent.

A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hounds not competing in the course in progress.

A return check fee of \$35.00 will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient funds.

NO ONE is allowed on the field without the express permission of the Field Chairman except the appointed Field Committee.
