**TESTS & STAKES OFFERED**

**JUNIOR COURSER TEST**

Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge assigned to one test and a second certification from a different judge assigned to another test, stating that the hound completed a 600-yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. It is strongly recommended that hounds that pass their JC test should be practiced with other hounds before being entered in the Open Stake to ensure absence of aggression on the field.

**QUALIFIED COURSER TEST**

A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed—or another breed with a similar running style—(Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

## ELIGIBLE HOUNDS

Afghan Hounds, Basenjis, Borzois, Cirneci dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis and Whippets that are one year of age or older, that have been registered with the AKC, or part of an AKC – registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the USA and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry, or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the prefix title of Field Champion and the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser.

FSS breeds Azawakh, Norbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengos (Medio & Grande) and Thai Ridgebacks may compete for suffix titles only.

## STAKES OFFERED

**OPEN:** Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title of record are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

**SPECIAL:** Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

**VETERAN:** Is offered at the option of the host club. It is open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

**SINGLES:** Open to all eligible breeds. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds entered in the Singles Stake shall not be allowed to enter the regular stakes (Open, Special or Veteran) at the same event. Each hound shall run the course alone. The order of running shall be determined by random draw. Judges shall score a dog's performance the same as a regular stake. Placements shall be awarded based on the combined preliminary and final course scores. The winner of the stake shall not be eligible to compete in Best of Breed. Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

## NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.

Each hound requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.

Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be refused entry and, if presented at inspection, will be refunded entry fees.

Spayed or neutered hounds may be entered.

The lure will consist of plastic contrasting in color with the immediate field environment.

Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC/CdECA/any hound(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.

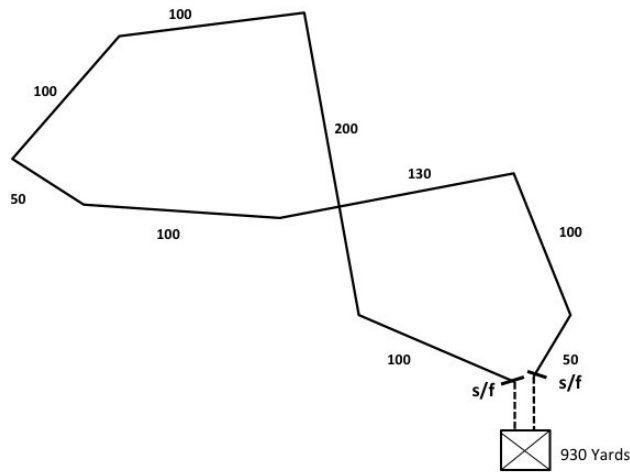

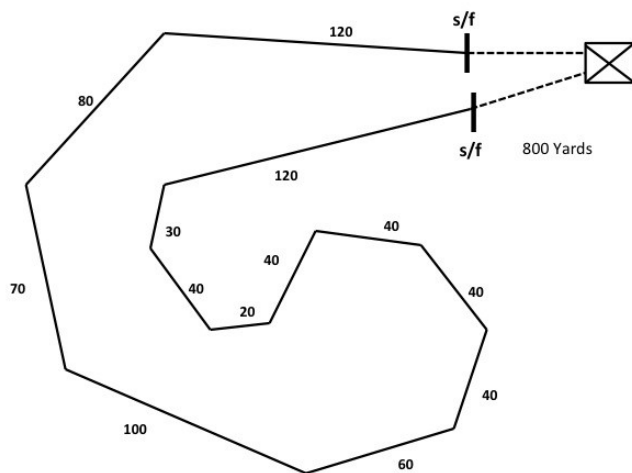

## DIRECTIONS

**From Fort Worth:** Take I-35W South for 53 miles; Merge with I-35E to become simply I-35. Travel another 33 miles and exit #337/Elm Avenue or US77. Bear LEFT on N Loop Drive to catch TX 484/Loop South toward Tx Hwy 6 to Marlin/Bryan/College Station. Pick up Hwy 6 South and take it all the way through Hearne, Calvert, Bryan, College Station and Navasota to pick up FM 1736 (Turn LEFT). Go 6½ and turn LEFT onto WALLER GLADISH RD. Go ½ mile and farm is on the LEFT.

**From Houston:** Take I-45 North to exit #48B/San Antonio to catch I-10 West. From I-10, exit 763/I-610 onto I-610 North. Go 1½ miles and follow the LEFT FORK onto US-290 West to Austin. Go 35 miles and exit FM 362. Turn RIGHT on FM 362 RD (FM-362) and travel 5½ miles to FM1488. Turn LEFT. Turn immediately RIGHT onto WALLER GLADISH RD (FM-1736,). Continue on FM 1736 RD/ WALLER GLADISH RD. The farm is on the LEFT.

**From Austin:** Take TX-71 East nearly 20 miles to transition into TX Hwy 21 East. Go another 18 miles and bear RIGHT to pick up US-290 East. Go 45 miles and follow signs for TX-36 S/HOUSTON/BELLEVILLE. After 22 miles, take Tx Hwy-6/BRYAN/HEMPSTEAD exit and continue on Hwy 6 South until FM 1736. Turn LEFT and go ½ mile and farm is on the LEFT.
