**TESTS**

**JUNIOR COURSER TEST**

Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge assigned to one test and a second certification from a different judge assigned to another test, stating that the hound completed a 600-yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

## QUALIFIED COURSER TEST

A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed—or another breed with a similar running style—(Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

## ELIGIBLE HOUNDS

Afghan Hounds, Basenjis, Borzois, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis and Whippets that are one year of age or older, that have been registered with the AKC, or part of an AKC – registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the USA and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry, or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the prefix title of Field Champion and the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser.

FSS breeds Azawakh\*, Norbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengos (Medio & Grande) and Thai Ridgebacks may compete for suffix titles only.

## STAKES OFFERED

**OPEN:** Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title of record are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

**SPECIAL:** Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

**VETERAN:** Is offered at the option of the host club. It is open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

**SINGLES:** Open to all eligible breeds. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds entered in the Singles Stake shall not be allowed to enter the regular stakes (Open, Special or Veteran) at the same event. Each hound shall run the course alone. The order of running shall be determined by random draw. Judges shall score a dog's performance the same as a regular stake.. Placements shall be awarded based on the combined preliminary and final course scores. The winner of the stake shall not be eligible to compete in Best of Breed. Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

**REFUNDS & SUBSTITUTIONS**

Pre-entry fees submitted and accepted with pre-entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for early-entries. Requests may be made by time-stamped email to the FTS or by direct contact (phone or in person) with the FTS. No refunds for pre-entry fees will be returned after the closing of early-entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season

Gate-entry fees submitted and accepted with gate-entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for day-of-trial-entries. Requests must be made in person to the FTS. No refunds for day-of-trial-entry fees will be returned after the closing of gate-entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season.

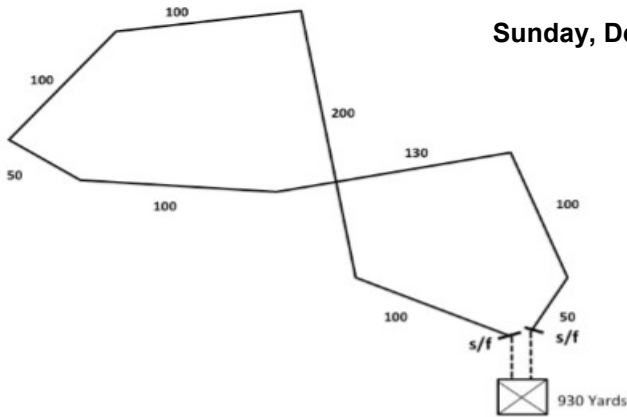

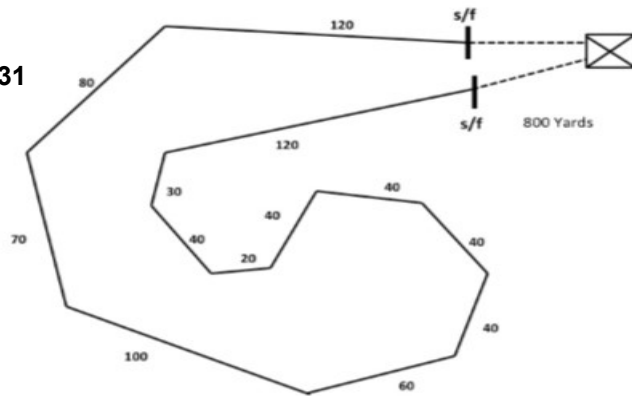
## COURSE PLANS

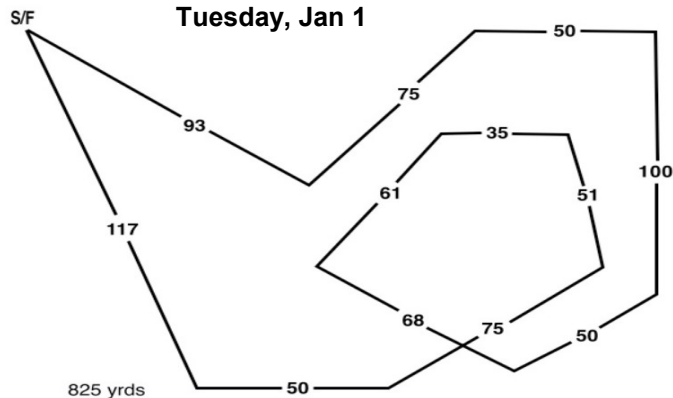

## NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.

Each hound requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.

Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications (except Singles stake entries) and lame hounds will be refused entry and, if presented at inspection, will be refunded entry fees.

Spayed or neutered hounds may be entered.

The lure will consist of plastic contrasting in color with the immediate field environment.

Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled.
